What is Angus Verified?

Angus Verified records the use of registered Angus sires, declares breeders and animals are purebred Angus and validates that the RFIDs of your sires are on your PIC at the time of joining to authenticate your purebred Angus breeding program.

How much does Angus Verified cost?

All prices are GST inclusive:

- · Manual Animal Records uploaded by Angus Australia charged at \$66/hr

What information do I have to record for my bulls in Angus Verified?

- · Your PIC Number
- · Angus Sire ID
- · RFID or NLIS ID of each bull

What information do I have to record for my animals to be Angus Verified?

- · Your PIC Number
- · Mob Name
- · RFID or NLIS ID of each animal
- · Birth Year
- · Angus Sire ID or Angus Sire Group Name
- · Breeder PIC Number
- · Birth Range by Month

What is a Breeder PIC Number?

The Breeder PIC number is the PIC number the mothers of the animals were on when they were joined.

Why do I have to provide my Angus.tech login and password to join Angus Verified?

These details are required to link your Angus Verified membership to your Angus Australia membership. If you do not have an Angus.tech login click HERE and register your details.

Why do I have to provide my NLIS User ID and Password to join Angus Verified?

These details are required to complete a third-party query of animals existing on your PIC to validate Angus Verified animals. This information is secured with blockchain technology and your private information is not visible to Angus Australia or Aglive.

Do I have to know which animals are by which bulls?

No, you can group all or some of your bulls into specific groups to enable you to allocate possible bulls of multiple animals in a mob.

If I breed my own or buy bulls that are unregistered, can they be used in Angus Verified?

No, but you can register your own bulls for use in Angus Verified. All bulls used in Angus Verified must be registered with Angus Australia in the Herd Book Register or the Angus Performance Register. For information on how to register animals with Angus Australia, please contact the Angus Australia Member Services Team.

What physical guidelines must cattle meet to comply with Angus Verified?

All animals that are Angus Verified must meet all requirements of the Black Angus Cattle Assessment Guidelines. Download by clicking HERE.

Will my Angus Verified data and cattle be checked by Angus Australia?

Yes, by joining Angus Verified you consent to Angus Australia undertaking random on-farm and/or remote audits on all data, animals, mothers, and bulls recorded in Angus Verified.

Can I identify my Angus Verified animals with Angus Verified tags?

Yes, you can purchase Angus Verified tags by requesting an Angus Verified Tag Order Form from Angus Australia via the Angus Verified App and Web Portal once you have verified your animals.

Angus Australia will email your order form directly to you and you must take this to your preferred rural reseller to submit and complete your order.

What do Angus Verified Tags look like?

Angus Verified Tags are Yellow, Maxi Female tags with a set design. No amendments or individual additions can be made to these tags.

Angus Verified Tags come in two options:

Management tags can be created for your desired number and letter sequence with up to 6 characters of space






Can I check if animals I have purchased are Angus Verified?

This allows you to ensure your purchased animals are Angus Verified and enables you to continue to market these animals further along the beef supply chain as Angus Verified.
