We are proud to invite you to the World Angus Technical Meeting in Czechia between 8 and 15 September 2023.

We will show you the best of what our country has to offer, focusing on what we have achieved in Angus breeding in the past 30 years. After four long years of absence, we would like to invite you to join us for the national show, a series of excellent presentations, trips to Angus farms around the country and, most importantly, meetings with old and new friends. We look forward to present our cattle and hospitality.

History and presence of Angus in Czechia

Despite the centuries-long tradition of cattle breeding in Czechia, beef cattle first came to the country just 30 years ago. In 1991, the first Angus heifers were imported from Canada, which laid the foundations for the breeding of Aberdeen Angus. Shortly after, they were followed by seedstock from all over the world. Czech Angus breed has enjoyed increasing popularity, with 5000 pedigree calves from 150 individual herds registered just last year. Ten times as many are reared as commercial cattle. Angus competes with Charolais for No. 1 among local beef breeds. A successful local market has developed for breeding bulls, while pedigree heifers have been sold mainly to emerging markets in southern and eastern Europe, and in central Asia. Many Angus farms run their own meat off farm sale.

Schedule

The event will launch in the historic city of České Budějovice, south of Prague. A day trip to neighbouring Angus farms will be followed by the National Angus Show that will present the hundred best animals from our breeders. On the third day, invited speakers will give us updates on recent developments in Angus breeding, which will be followed by World Angus Secretariat meeting.

Afterwards, you can look forward to a four-day trip filled with exciting stops, including Angus farms, wine cellars at a monastery, a Prague boat tour, and, beer and delicious food on the way, among others. Those who would like to stay on can join us on a further 3-day trip around farms and sights of interest.
